

Tolay Fall Festival Champion Seed Spitting Competition back at the Tolay Fall Festival

The Tolay Fall Festival will be holding the World Record Pumpkin Seed Spitting Contest on Saturdays and Sundays during the Festival.

Take a chance to be this years seed spitting champion. Overall male and female winners will be forever honored on a commemorative plaque that future spitters around the world strive toward.



Bring the whole family to the Tolay Fall Festival with world record seed spitting on Saturdays and Sundays at 3:00pm. The festival is open to the public October 13th, 14th, 19th, 20th and 21st from 9:00am to 3:00pm and October 14th, 15th, 22nd, and 23rd from 11:00am to 5:00pm.

Be sure to start practicing with the World Record Seed Spitting rules:

- 1. The contestants will be divided into 3 age's groups: Ages 12 and under; ages 13-18; and ages 19 & over.**
- 2. Each contestant will be allowed to spit 3 pumpkin seeds. The distance of the furthest of the three seeds will be measured and recorded as the contestant's competition spit.**
- 3. Seeds for the contest will be provided by Regional Parks. Any person caught using his/her own seeds will be immediately disqualified.**
- 4. The starting area will be designated by a marked line. If the contestant steps over this line, he/she will be disqualified.**
- 5. The distance is measured from the starting line to the nearest point of the seed.**
- 6. Prizes will be awarded to male and female winners from each age group.**
- 7. Overall Male and Female winners will be honored on a plaque placed at Tolay Lake Regional Park.**
