This Notice of Virtual Public Hearing was issued during the Sonoma County Shelter in Place order.

WHO:

Project Applicant, Timothy Crites with CSCF, LLC and Erich Pearson with WWCMC, Inc, Permit Sonoma File No. UPC19-0002

WHAT: The applicants requests a five-year limited-term Use Permit for 20,000 square feet of centralized cannabis processing, and 28,560 square feet of outdoor cultivation, 5,000 square feet of indoor wholesale nursery cannabis, 10,000 square feet of mixed-light cultivation, 10,890 square feet of propagation and a distributor-transportation only. The project would be allowed to conduct cultivation activities and indoor processing activities twenty-four hours per day, seven days a week as needed. Deliveries and shipping would be limited to 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The operation would be supported by 17 employees on a 29.20-acre parcel located at 101 Trinity Road, Glen Ellen, **APN 053-110-001 and 053-130-009. Supervisorial District 1.**

Parcel Zoning: Land Intensive Agriculture (LIA) with a maximum 100-acre density (B6 Combining District), and Taylor/Sonoma/Mayacamas Mountains (Local Guidelines Combining District), Riparian Corridor (RC50/25) and Scenic Resources Community Separator and Scenic Corridor Combining District (SR).

An Initial Study was prepared pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, and the project's potential environmental impacts have been analyzed. A Mitigated Negative Declaration is proposed which finds that potential environmental impacts have been fully mitigated to less-than-significant levels.
